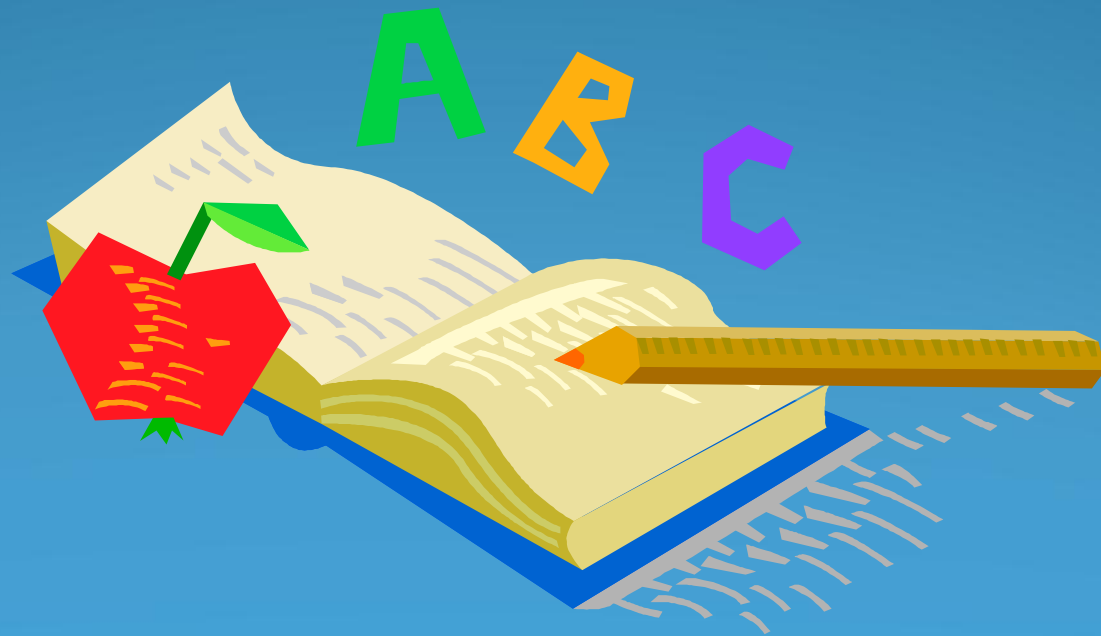

- Homework sent out each Friday. This does not need to come back to school and is key skills practice.

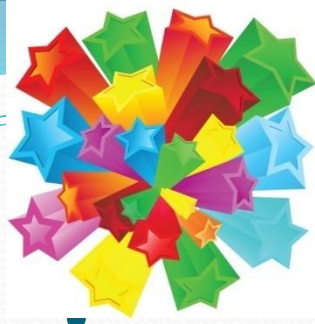
# A typical day in Year 1

# Behaviour

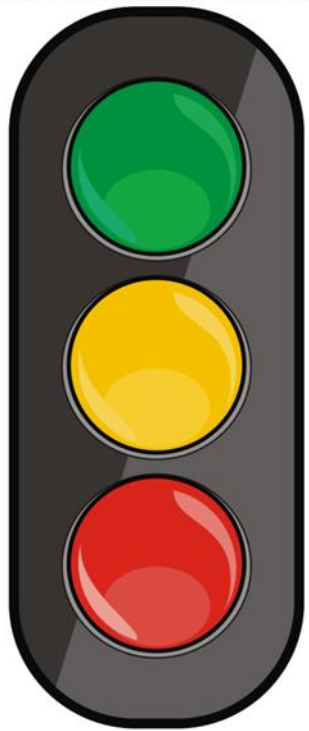
The class have created their own 'Class Charter', where we have agreed our class expectations.

# Behaviour: Traffic Light System



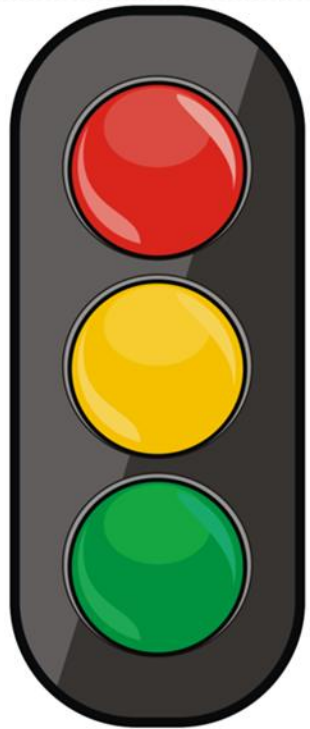
Green – Expected Behaviour

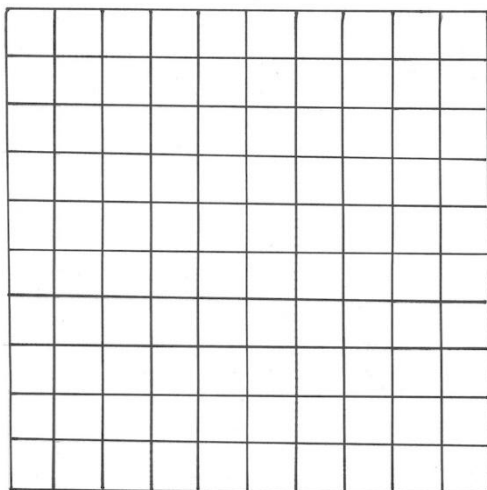


# Rewards

# Reading



- Children who read regularly, share books and listen to adults reading, become readers!
- Phonics is taught daily.
- Every week, your child will take part in a variety of reading activities which will include phonics sessions, independent reading, talk through stories and reading to an adult.
- During explore time children will have access to a wide variety of texts, story telling opportunities through small world play and puppet creation.
- You have been given your log in to record your child's reading on Boom reader – we will also record any reading here too.

- Spelling in RWI and weekly focus words

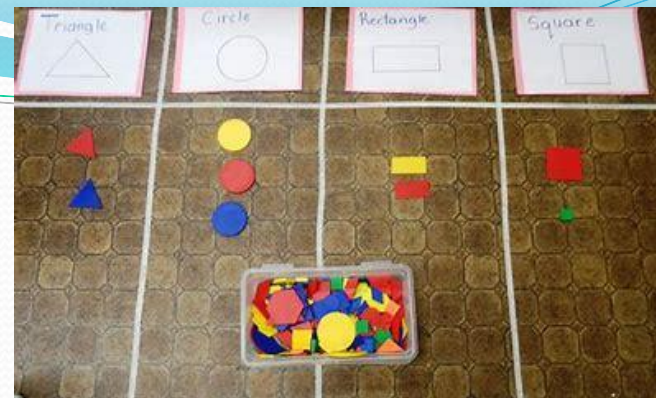
