Growing Challenge

We will send each child home with a sunflower seed. You could use a recycled container to make your own plant pot. Plant your seeds in your pot with some soil and watch them closely. Make sure you look after them!

As a gardener, you will need to:

1. Research what seeds need to grow.
2. Look after the plant daily.



Keeping a Diary

Keep a weekly picture diary of how your seeds have changed over time.

As a diary writer, you will need to:

1. Set a day when you are going to observe your plant.
2. Think about how you are going to record what you have seen.
(Photographs, drawings etc.)
3. Label your weekly picture thinking about
 - What has changed?
 - What can you see?
 - How could you measure it?

All home learning will be shared in class the week beginning **18th May**. We do not need your plants bringing in only your pictures or diaries and/or posters.
