The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is always our highest priority. As a precaution, we kindly ask that children do **not bring squishy toys or similar items into school**.

We will also be reminding pupils of our expectations regarding personal items, and staff will monitor this during the school day.

We appreciate your support in reinforcing this message at home, as it helps us to maintain a safe environment for all children.
