An inspirational project to create Art

Home Learning Challenge

We will be exploring emotions and how they are connected to colour.

As you begin to create your own masterpieces, you will need to research how artists use colour to show feelings in their work.

You will need to choose an abstract artist such as Kandinsky or Clee and find out how they express their emotions through colour, shape and form.

Once you have completed your research, create your own artwork inspired by your chosen artist's style. You must also write one paragraph explaining your piece. In your explanation, describe how and why you used specific colours, textures, shapes and forms, so that visitors can understand your ideas.

As an artist, you will:

1. Research your chosen **abstract** artist.
2. Explore how they show different emotions in their work.
3. Create your own artwork inspired by your artist.
4. Write a paragraph to explaining your artistic choices.



Notes to Parents/Carers:

Children may use any medium to complete their artwork, including paint, coloured pencils or collage materials.

How you can support your child:

- Help them research their chosen artist and ensure they use the internet safely.
- Take time to listen to their ideas before they begin creating their artwork.
- Encourage them to work carefully and thoughtfully, allowing plenty of time to complete their piece.
- Ask them to explain their artistic choices to you before they present their work at school.
