Home Learning challenge:

As a historical quiz master, you need to:

Part 1: Due in 8th May 2026

Research information about your line of enquiry (a specific question or topic about Viking life). You can choose how you would like to share the information you have discovered.

1. Identify your line of enquiry;
2. Research aspects of this area;
3. Share your findings (e.g. poster, presentations)

Part 2: Due in 18th May 2026

Write a quiz (and an answer sheet), using the information you discovered, to act as the final part of your study guide and bring this into school ready to share with the year group.

1. Decide how to present your quiz;
2. Write 10 questions about your line of enquiry;
3. Write the answer sheet (on a separate page).
