## There are changes in Free School Meals !



You will have received an email about this. There have been changes in the funding and rules have changes.

If you currently receive Free School Meals, you must re-apply as funding will stop for your current application on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2026.

You can apply online for free school meals, please see link [complete an application](#) to ensure correct funding is received where it is due. This is especially important for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, who already receive universal free school meals, but may not be attracting the additional funding that they would if they complete this application.
