Dear Parents and Carers of children in years 3 – 6 in September 2026

From September 2026 we are hoping to be able to provide private music lessons in the following instruments. These lessons will need to be paid for by parents and your child will need their own instrument. Approximate costs for lessons are £13 – 20 min lesson, on an individual basis, with 10 lessons per term. All lessons are in school lesson time, break time or lunch time. Your child will need to have their own instrument for their lesson and to practise at home.

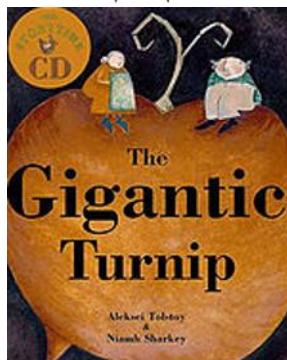

FREE SCHOOL MEALS – UPDATE – Please read

There have been changes in the funding and rules have changes.

If you currently receive Free School Meals, you must re-apply as funding will stop for your current application on 31st August 2026.

You can apply online for free school meals, please see link [complete an application](#) to ensure correct funding is received where it is due. This is especially important for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, who already receive universal free school meals, but may not be attracting the additional funding that they would if they complete this application.

Re: Free School Meal Eligibility Changes for the new Academic Year – 2026/27

Free School Meals Transitional Protection will be ending at the end of the current school year, and you will need to reapply if you meet the new criteria.

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 Academic Year, the Government plans to expand access to Free School Meals to all children and young people from households receiving Universal Credit, and there will be 2 categories of eligibility.

Eligible Targeted: this covers children in households in receipt of Universal Credit with annual household earnings of £7,400 or less. These children will attract Pupil Premium and other disadvantage funding for their schools. Other education entitlements, such as the Holiday Activities and Food program (HAF) and the 'extended rights' element of School Transport Assistance will be based on the Targeted Free School Meals.

Eligible Expanded: this covers children who are in households receiving Universal Credit with annual household earnings exceeding £7,400. These children will be entitled to Free School Meals only.

Due to these changes, everyone will be required to reapply, from 1st June 2026. We strongly recommend applying online as early as possible to allow for your application to be processed in readiness for the new Academic Year. You can apply online via the BCP Council Free School Meals webpage: [Free school meals | BCP](#)

If you are unable to apply online, you can obtain an application form from either your child's school or by contacting us directly, our details can be found at the top of this letter. Please ensure that you complete application forms in full and in block capitals to avoid delays in processing.

Please note, applications for the next Academic Year, are unlikely to be processed within our standard 3-5 working day timeframe as a result of the number of applications we will be receiving during this time. Therefore, applicants may need to wait several weeks for a response.

Please note, if your child is currently receiving Free School Meals, their eligibility will continue to be protected until the end of the current school year regardless of the outcome of your new application.

Once your application has been processed, you will receive a letter via email to inform you of the outcome. If you are eligible, we will confirm under which category you are eligible and advise what level of support your child will receive.

If you are eligible under the Targeted category, you will be entitled to Free School Meal support for the entire 2026/27 Academic Year, even if you have a change in circumstances.

If you are eligible under the Expanded category, you will also be entitled to Free School Meal support for the entire 2026/27 Academic Year, however, if you have a change in circumstances whereby you now meet the criteria for Targeted Free School Meals, please reapply so that we can reassess your eligibility and your child may then receive the additional support available within this category.

Families with No Recourse to Public Funds (NRPF):

If you are a family with NRPF and your child is currently in receipt of NRPF Free School Meals, you do not need to reapply at this time, and from September 2026 your child will receive support under the Targeted category. We will contact you if you need to reapply in the future, however, as previously instructed you must inform us of any change in circumstances that mean you no longer meet the NRPF Free School Meal criteria.

After two weeks of struggling at home, I was finally diagnosed with Haemolytic Uraemic Syndrome (HUS), a serious condition that primarily affects the kidneys and is often caused by an infection with E. coli. During my week-long stay at Southampton Hospital, my parents were very thankful to stay at the local Ronald Macdonald House, staying close to me whilst I was hospitalised. I am now in the best shape of my life. So I want to give back. Every mile I conquer and every pound I raise helps provide a home away from home for families with hospitalised children, ensuring they can stay close without the burden of costly accommodation.

This invaluable support means families are never far from their child's bedside and can return quickly when needed, without the stress of long, unpredictable and potentially expensive journeys.
