Year 3 Update

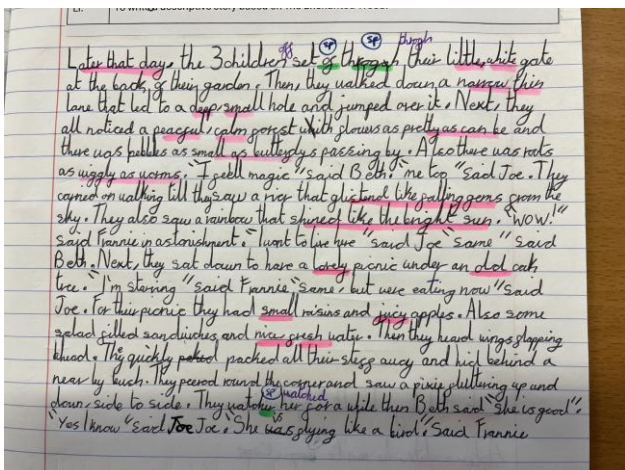

Y5 L1/2 Bikeability Training Parent/Carer Booking Information for Hill View Primary School

Dear Parent / Carer,

Your child's class will be taking part in Free Bikeability Cycle training provided by BCP Council from: **10th June to 19th June 2026**. These sessions will take place during the normal school day. Your child will be notified of which day/date they will need their cycle to attend the course. If there is a child off sick then your child may be asked to fill this particular slot at short notice, to allow for all riders who have booked onto the course to be able to take part. Please do not share the link with any other parent other than another Y5 only as we cannot accommodate younger siblings for example on this course.

Bikeability has replaced Cycling Proficiency as the government's national cycle training programme. It is funded by the Department for Transport and is delivered by trained, DBS-checked Bikeability instructors.

Bikeability trains riders to make independent decisions and practice safe and responsible cycling. It is offered at different levels to support your child's increasing skills and confidence. Riders must demonstrate all assessment criteria for each level independently before they progress on to the next Bikeability level.

Your child's instructor will work with the school to advise you when your child is ready for the next level. These levels are:-

- **Learn to Ride** – develops basic skills in riding a pedal bike without stabilisers.
- **Playground Bike Skills (Level 1)** - develops cycle handling skills before riding on the road.
- **Residential Road Training (Level 2)** develops skills for cycling on single-lane roads with simple junctions and moderate traffic.

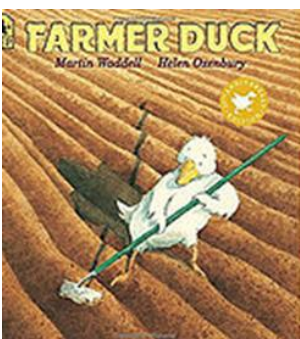

Family coaching is for adults only. Separate counselling is available for children and young people.

WHAT INFORMATION IS SHARED?
RAFT's service is independent of the Local Authority. BCP Council will only be aware that you have accessed this service with your prior consent. This is your choice.

RAFT Family coaching helps families make radical and lasting change. Sound too good to be true? Don't just take our word for it. Here's what our parents and carers have to say...

"I found helpful ways to communicate and possible reasoning behind issues we struggle for more especially more recently due to neurodiversity in the house."

"My children are calmer, happier, more open to talking with us and spending time together. We have less arguments."

"We worked through a couple of important problems that were quite difficult for us to deal with on our own. We've also started making more time to talk with each other in the evenings."

For up-to-date information on daily venue activities, please check in with us. Below is an example of our scheduled holiday club activities.

Morning Schedule

- 08:00 - 08:45: Early sign-in and hot! Our leaders will have activities set up ready to start the day before the majority of children arrive on camp.
