Our Year 2 pupils have had an exceptional half term, showing curiosity, creativity and real determination across every subject. Their classrooms have been buzzing with ideas, teamwork and some truly impressive achievements.

In maths, the children have become confident young data-handlers. They have created their own **bar graphs** from scratch, carefully choosing categories, labelling axes and interpreting the information with growing independence. They have also been reading and organising **pictograms**, spotting patterns and answering questions using the data they collected themselves. Their teachers have been blown away by how quickly they've mastered these skills.

In English, Year 2 have taken a classic tale and made it entirely their own. After exploring the traditional story of *Hansel and Gretel*, they planned and wrote **twisted tales** filled with imaginative settings, surprising plot twists and wonderfully vivid description. From enchanted forests made of glowing crystals to villains with unexpected secrets, their writing has shown both creativity and confidence. Many pupils have produced their best work of the year.

Across the board, their enthusiasm has been infectious. They've asked thoughtful questions, supported one another brilliantly and taken real pride in their learning.

We couldn't be prouder of everything they've achieved — and we can't wait to see what they do next.

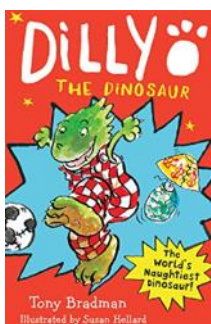

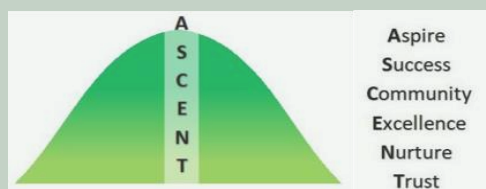

Schedule Example

For up-to-date information on daily venue activities, please check in with us. Below is an example of our scheduled holiday club activities and our confirmed weekly themes.

Morning Schedule

- 08:00 - 08:30:** Early sign-ins arrive! Our leaders will have activities set up ready to start the day before the majority of children arrive on camp.
- 08:45 - 09:15:** The main arrival time. Sign-ins and warm-up with free play.
- 09:15 - 09:30:** Group circle time. All children will gather round for circle time as we introduce the exciting activities planned for the day ahead.
- 09:30 - 11:00:** Sports carousel outside and a creative workshop inside.
- 11:00 - 11:15:** Snack Break! Refresh with snacks to keep energy levels high for the next batch of activities.
- 11:15 - 12:15:** Your child will have the choice to participate in age-group matches with alternative sports activities like gymnastics and dance also available. Alternatively, there will be indoor 'about decorating and themed crafting station like making summer bunting, daisy chains and friendship bracelets.

Lunchtime & Afternoon

- 12:15 - 12:45:** Lunchtime! Those who have paid for hot lunches will enjoy a warm meal with their friends.
